Eco-Healthy Child Care® (EHCC) is a national program that partners with childcare professionals to eliminate or reduce environmental health hazards found within or around childcare facilities. 42% of young children spend at least 35 hours a week in some form of child care. Therefore, creating a healthy early learning environment is key to the health of our nation's children. Emerging science is linking chemicals commonly found in childcare settings to asthma, lower IQ, and developmental disabilities. Environmental exposures can contribute to these conditions. Learn how to create a healthy environment at your program through simple, free or low-cost best practices. Topics addressed: pest control, air quality, household chemicals, furniture & carpets, art supplies, plastics & plastic toys, lead, mercury, arsenic, and radon.
