## HEALTH AND SAFETY TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP REIMBURSEMENT FORM LICENSED AND LICENSE EXEMPT PROVIDERS

Sierra Nevada Children's Services has funds available from the Early Education and Support Division of the California Department of Education for Quality Improvement Activities. Reimbursements will be made until the funds for the fiscal year are expended. The maximum reimbursement shall not exceed \$150 per applicant per fiscal year. Center-based staff (maximum of two staff per fiscal year), license-exempt providers, family child care providers, and one paid assistant per FCCH are eligible for reimbursements. Applicants are responsible for \$10 co-pay. All training curriculum must be EMSA approved.
